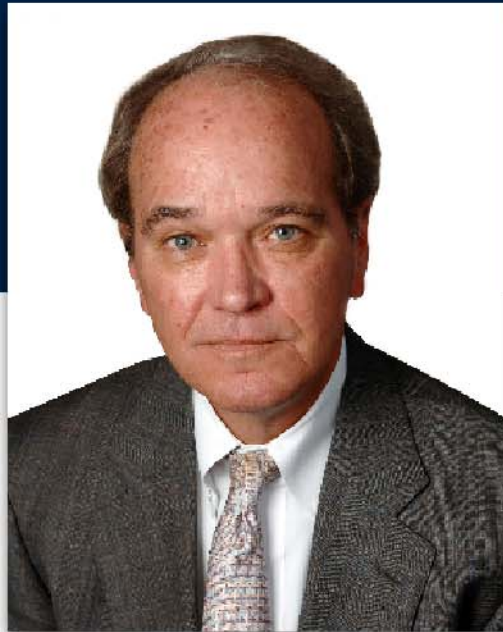


Patrick Egan

Patrick has been involved in hundreds of hotel counseling and appraisal assignments throughout the United States. Local projects include the majority of the principal CBD and French Quarter properties, including the Hilton and the Sheraton. He has been published on hospitality related issues.
